

What to consider when painting with Colorbond®

You can now highlight architectural features of your home and match the colour and sheen to new or existing Colorbond® Steel such as roofing, guttering, fence or fascias etc.



Colour Considerations

If you already have a dark Colorbond® steel roof colour, use a lighter wall colour on your home and use the roof as contrast or paint the fascias a complimentary colour to balance the scheme.

Preparation

When painting existing Colorbond® or Zinalume® surfaces.

Ensure new or weathered Zinalume®, or weathered Colorbond® are clean and free of salts or other deposits.

New Colorbond® should be scoured with a nylon scourer prior to painting.

When painting Colorbond® roofs used for collecting rainwater, downpipes must be disconnected from tanks before painting

and not reconnected until after the roof has been thoroughly rinsed by repeated heavy rainfalls. On roofs where drinking water is collected a first-flush water diverter system must be installed.

Prior to painting ensure surface is clean and dry, and free from chalking, loose friable material, dust, dirt and grease. All loose, peeling or flaking material must be removed. If mould is present, clean surface with household bleach then rinse well with clean water.
